HELPFUL HINTS TO BETTER PREPARE FOR A DISASTER...

- Plan how you will communicate during a disaster. Have a weather radio for alerts.
- Plan for food, water, and essentials for you and pets or service animals.
- Have a sufficient supply of medicines, medical supplies, batteries and chargers readily available.
- Plan for transportation if you need help evacuating.
- Plan how you will evacuate with any assistive devices, such as wheelchairs.
- Make copies important documents including of Medicaid, Medicare and other insurance cards.
- Have contact information for family, care providers or medical providers available.

TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE MONDAY - APRIL 8, 2024

At approximately 3:12 pm a total Solar Eclipse will make its way through Richland County, Ohio. More than 100,000 visitors are expected over the weekend.

How will this affect me?

With the influx of visitors traffic gridlock and delays are expected. Altered traffic patterns may be implemented across the county. Many schools will be closed. Your work schedule may be adjusted. PREPARE TO SHELTER IN PLACE.

What can you do to prepare for this event?

- Run errands/grocery shop early in the week for food and Rx. Have essentials on hand.
- Fill up your gas tank before that weekend.
- Consider scheduling medical and other appointments earlier in the week or after April 8th.
